

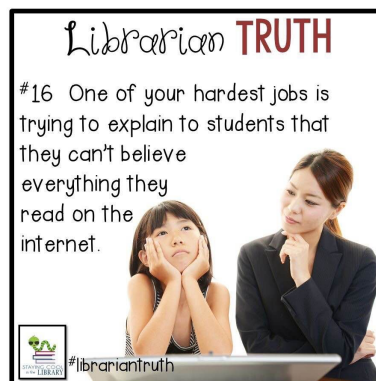
# Trust Issues - Evaluating Websites
